Please note: Participants of this tour must be physically fit and able to walk about 1.5 miles. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable closed shoes. The tour itinerary may be reversed. This tour involves winding roads, which may be unsuitable for those who suffer with vertigo and car-sickness. Walking on the suspension bridge is unsuitable for pregnant guests, or guest who suffer from vertigo. The minimum age for the suspension bridge 7 years old. ## MAR16 - Folkloric Martinique & Rum Distillery TOUR

CULTURE AND HISTORY





For an authentic taste of Martinique, step off the ship, board a coach and travel through the rainforest to one of the island's best rum distilleries. On the way, a stop will be made at Balata Church, an exact miniature replica of the Basilica of the Sacred Heart in Paris that affords a spectacular view of Fort-de-France and the bay. You will stop at the Volcano museum situated at the foot of the mountain Pelée to understand the eruption history. A visit to the Depaz rum distillery will not only give you a chance to learn a little about the process of making rum, but also let you sample the special rhum agricole, which is distilled only in Martinique and is made using freshly squeezed sugarcane juice rather than the conventional molasses. A 10-minute drive from the distillery will take you St. Pierre, the former cultural capital of Martinique that was tragically destroyed in a major outbreak of Mount Pelée in 1902. The modern-day town of St. Pierre is France's 101st "City of Art and History". After visiting the Ruins of the theatre, your return trip to Fort-de-France will take you through Le Carbet, the spot where Columbus landed in 1502 and the town that inspired Gauguin to paint some of his most beguiling canvases. Also on the itinerary are Bellefontaine and its famous boat-shaped house as well as Schoelcher, a seaside resort that was named after a 19th-century French abolitionist writer. Please note: the tour itinerary may be reversed. As this tour involves travelling along winding roads, it may be unsuitable for guests who are susceptible to motion sickness. Shooting videos and taking photos are not permitted inside the Morne Rouge Volcano Museum.

Take some time out from your ship and board a minibus for a short ride from Fort-de-France, the capital of Martinique, to the scenic Rue de la Fontaine Didier hiking trail. Look forward to a gentle hike on well-maintained roads through the most spectacular landscape, marked by lush rainforest vegetation, tropical trees and an abundance of wildlife. The trail also takes you past a number of lovely waterfalls before you arrive at Absalon, the final destination of your hike. You will then have time to have a rest, relax and enjoy a well-earned drink on the banks of a small river. To save your feet, a comfortable minibus will then be waiting to take you on an equally scenic return drive to the port and your ship. Please note: guests must be in good physical health and at least 10 years of age to take part. Children must be accompanied by a paying adult (parent/legal guardian) throughout the tour and be under their supervision at all times. Guests are recommended to wear sports or mountain shoes suitable for hiking. All participating guests will be required to sign a waiver which may only be available in English.

First you will cross the national park of Guadeloupe with its dense tropical forest, and enjoying the refreshing Cascade aux Écrevisses. Afterwards the Domaine de Valombreuse botanical garden which will captivate you with its exceptional richness: here you will enjoy the primary forest nearby orchids and cacao trees, the palm grove and spectacular exotic plants. Through sugarcane plantations, you will then visit a genuine colonial property and the estate where you will be able to taste one of the Caribbean's best "rum agricole". Please note: This tour ends at the port for transit guests and at the airport for guests who are disembarking and booked on flights after 5pm. The duration of the tour also includes the time for transfer to the airport. ## **GUA11 - SCENIC DRIVE AND WALK TO CARBET WATERFALLLS**

NATURAL WONDERS

The southern end of Basse-Terre island is dominated by the La Grande Soufrière volcano, which rises to a majestic height of 1467 m amid Guadeloupe's lush green rainforest. It is also where you'll find the gorgeous Carbet Waterfalls, the main highlight of this tour. After boarding a comfortable coach at the port of Pointe-à-Pitre, your journey to the famous falls - consisting of three separate cascades - will first take you through the Capesterre-Belle-Eau region to the island's Hindu temple, a testament to Guadeloupe's multi-ethnic society. A photo stop will be made at this colourfully decorated place of worship, following which the picturesque route continues right into the rainforest and to the 110-m mid-level fall. An exhilarating walk will then take you to the viewing platform, which affords truly breathtaking views of the cascade as it gushes through the dense vegetation. The sun glinting on the sparkling water coming over the mountainside is a perfect photo moment, so do remember to bring your camera. Your tour then draws to a leisurely close with your scenic journey back to your ship. Please note: for reasons of safety, direct access to the falls and the pool has been prohibited, by order of the National Park Authorities, since 2004. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests with mobility problems. Guests are recommended to wear comfortable clothing and sturdy walking shoes. Accessing the viewing platform involves going up/down approx. 400 steps.

On the road to the fishing village of Deshaies, the tour leaves from the port of Pointe à Pitre and ventures into the very fertile northern part of the Island of Basse-Terre. During this commented ride on the picturesque roads snaking through sugar cane plantations you will stop to admire the beach of Grande Anse and make a nice photo stop before to visit the best Botanical Garden in the Caribbean: le Jardin Botanique de Deshaies. Here you will find without doubt the most various and beautiful flower's and plant's species in all the Caribbean: it is the right place for nature lovers. Look at the flamingos in the pond, the bougainvillea's alley, the orchids, the cactus gardens and the aviary among the several attractions. A short drive and you will reach a pleasant seafront resort for an hour of idleness and relaxation. Your sun bed awaits you on the wonderful caramel tinted sand. A complimentary drink will be served at the beach bar allowing you to further enjoy the outing before heading back to the ship. Please note: Guests are recommended to wear light clothing, swimsuit, towel, sunscreen, hat, and flat comfortable shoes.

A modern motor boat will pick you up directly at the Cruise ship pier. Through the Rivière Salée (Salt River) and the mangrove ecosystem you will reach the Grand-Cul-de-Sac-Marin, part of the National Park of Guadeloupe. Your guide instructor will accompany you snorkeling at the coral reef and will show you the sea-life of this extraordinary environment, world biological reserve of the UNESCO. The second part of the tour has as scenery the near and enchanting sandy island where you will enjoy the beautiful beach with your complimentary drink. The way back to the port is as well an instructive and surprising boat trip through the natural and breathtaking landscapes of Guadeloupe. Please note: Children minimum age: 4. Guests should be able to swim. Snorkeling material is included and available in the motorboat for all guests.

### **GUA19 - GUADELOUPE HIGHLIGHTS**

**CITY TOUR** 

This tour of Grande-Terre island begins with a short drive to one of Guadeloupe's key historical monuments, the mid-18th-century Fort Fleur d'épée. Situated high above the coastal town of Le Gosier on the southern shores of Grand-Terre, the fortress once played a critical role in the Seven Years' War between France and Great Britain, but is now used to host temporary art exhibitions. Moving on, you'll then stop in Le Gosier itself for lovely views of one of Guadeloupe's most popular snapshot scenes: the Îlet du Gosier. Located just a stone's throw out to sea, this tiny coral isle is home to swaying palm trees and a pretty lighthouse. Leaving Le Gosier, you will reach Sainte Anne for a pleasant stop at the Village Artisanal on the sea front. As you then make your way through Sainte-Anne's lushly vegetated Le Grands Fonds region, you'll be heading for a final photo stop at the cemetery, famed for its black-and-white checkerboard tombs, before returning to your ship.

A scenic drive along the southern coastline will see you reach St. Anne, a fishing village noted for its lovely seafront promenade and local handcraft products. As the outing continues you will stop for a refreshing drink before heading east along the coastal road to the Pointe des Châteaux, an incredible rock formation sculpted by the wind to resemble a castle's crenellations. A walk will take you up to the highest spot, from where you'll catch spectacular views of the neighbouring Caribbean islands - simply perfect for a photo or two. You'll then reach Morne-à-L'Eau, a town curiously noted for its artistic cemetery, which represents the unique black-and-white architecture of the West Indies. A short drive will then take you from Morne-à-L'Eau back to your ship. Please note: the path up to Pointe des Châteaux involves going up/down approx. 400 steps. Guests are recommended to bring a bottle of water on the tour.

## TRT01 - "THE BATHS" BEACH AREA ON VIRGIN GORDA

Swap your ship for a boat and first enjoy a 40-minute jaunt to Spanish Town on Virgin Gorda before hopping on an open, safari-style coach for a further five-minute ride to the stunning beach area known as "The Baths". Amid the natural beauty of this special place, you can swim, snorkel or simply explore the surroundings. One of the British Virgin Islands' most popular sights, "The Baths" are an unusual geological formation consisting of huge, sea-sculpted granite boulders that line the beach and form tidal pools, tunnels, caves, arches and scenic grottoes. After some time to shop for a souvenir, you will rejoin the coach. As a final touch, a complimentary drink will be served before you re-board the launch. ### STT01 - ST. KITTS BEACH BREAK

On leaving the port you will travel through Basseterre to the tourist and residential resort area of Frigate Bay. This is the scenic area, where the land narrows making it possible to view the cresting foams of the Atlantic coast and the tranquil waters of the Caribbean Sea separated only by part of the Royal St. Kitts Golf Course and a few resort accommodations. You will drive up Timothy Hill, the entrance to the Southeast Peninsula. You will enjoy a breathtakingly beautiful drive over the rolling hills, each gentle turn providing a different spectacular view - the sea on either side; the land interrupted by salt ponds of differing size. 11 kilometres of natural landscape and environment! You finally arrive at the bar and restaurant on the beach with beautiful vistas of Nevis. A warm smiling Caribbean welcome awaits you. Walk out to the oversized wooden decks decorated with upscale Caribbean themes and then onto the beach with the beautiful sea and the whispers of lapping waves. There is a gift shop, outdoor grill and bar and some water sports available. Spend time walking the beach, swimming or sun-bathing. A beach chair and refreshing drink have been reserved for you at the beachfront restaurant. Relax and enjoy Please note: This tour is not suitable for guests with limited mobility.

### STT15 - DISCOVER ST. KITTS

Your excursion gets off to a start with a driving tour of Basseterre. Basseterre, founded in 1625, later became the capital of St. Kitts in 1727. Historical Basseterre was first ruled by the French from the mid 1600's to the early 1700's when the English took over the reins of ownership. Efforts have been made to maintain aspects of Caribbean architecture that was greatly inspired by both the European and African heritage of the island. Stop at the Roman Catholic Co-Cathedral on your way to the next stop, Romney Manor, home of the world famous Caribelle Batik. Visit the demonstration room, where the acclaimed artists illustrate the wax and dye process of batik making. The Romney Manor Estate encompasses eight acres of historical ruins, ancient Carib Indian Rock drawings and a beautiful botanical garden. Then you will be transported back to your awaiting ship.

## STT20 - 4X4 ISLAND SAFARI & BEACH

Experience a touch of tropical rainforest and off roading pleasure in the heart of St. Kitts, as well as a refreshing swim in the magical Caribbean Sea. Board your vehicle at the pier and head inland traveling through villages and then up into cool mountain rainforests. As you travel off road into the interior of St. Kitts in specially modified 4x4 Land Rovers, you will explore the lush rain forest where it is possible to see shy, green Monkeys and other exotic tropical flora and fauna. At a private mountain top property, 1000 feet above sea level, enjoy panoramic views over the island's rainforest and quilted coastline, inclusive of the capital city of Basseterre and our sister island, Nevis. Here you will be served a local fresh fruit juice. Be sure to bring your camera for exquisite photo opportunities. Your journey then continues through the mountains to the opposite side of the island where you discover quaint villages and the country life of St. Kitts. Going through the village of Cayon, the historical St. Mary's Church will be pointed out to you as well as traditional village homes and farmers' gardens. Drive along the windswept Atlantic coastline as you head towards the beach for a refreshing swim in the Caribbean Sea. Relax and unwind, swim off the golden sand beach or just beach comb before returning to port. Please Note: Minimum age requirement is 4 years old. The Land Rovers travel on bumpy unpaved roads. Pregnant women and guests with back/neck injuries or respiratory ailments are not permitted on this excursion. This tour is not suitable for guests with walking disabilities or problems with mobility, no wheelchairs or walkers.

STT21 - ESSENTIAL ST. KITT

**CITY TOUR** 

A golden opportunity to see the best of St. Kitts awaits you on this half-day tour, with a first stop at Romney Manor in Basseterre. Dating back to the 17th-century, this former sugar estate boasts nearly 5 hectares/12 acres of landscaped gardens and is also home to Caribelle Batik. The complex and highly artistic dyeing process that goes to produce beautiful batiks is carried out entirely by hand here - to stunning effect. Moving on, you'll head out of town up to a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the 17th-/18th-century Brimstone Hill Fortress that oversees the surrounding area. The extremely well preserved site affords fabulous views of five neighbour isles, St. Kitts' beautiful landscape and of the coastline - perfect for a photo or two. The history theme continues with a visit to the Fairview Great House, a card-carrying reminder of St. Kitts' colonial era. Feast your eyes on stupendous vistas of the Caribbean Sea, the southeast peninsula and Nevis, St. Kitts' sister isle, from the veranda, then explore the wide variety of flowering plants, fruit trees, palms and shrubs found in the well-established botanical gardens, whose oldest sections date back to the 1700s. As the tour winds down with a drive around Basseterre, watch out for its colonial architecture, old churches, cottages and even the site of a former slave market before you return to your ship. Please note: guests are recommended to wear light comfortable clothing and shoes, high-factor sunscreen and to bring a camera. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests using a wheelchair.

Continue your journey for your next stop at Caribelle Batik, an establishment that has gained a formidable reputation throughout the Caribbean for its batik prints. Departing from Caribelle, the drive offers great views and a photo stop at Marigot Bay overlook. Afterwards, you will pass traditional fishing villages as you travel the scenic west coast road to Soufriere. You will see many of the famous sights starting with the stunning Pitons, a UNESCO world-heritage site, as you arrive in SoufriereYou will drive through town on to the 18th century old Soufriere Estate. Upon arrival, a knowledgeable guide will explain how coconuts are opened, roasted in a traditional oven and turned into copra (dry coconut) before being processed into everyday items such as soap, sun tan lotion and cooking oil, and how cocoa is fermented, dried on racks in the sun and crushed into powder to make cocoa sticks before being made into chocolate. Then enjoy a delicious buffet lunch at the Old Mill with its spinning waterwheel built in 1765. After lunch, you will re-board your bus and take a short drive to Soufriere bay where you will board a customized sail and/or engine-powered catamaran. You will cruise north along the coast, relax and top up your tan before stopping for a refreshing swim at one of the island's secluded bays. On your return to Castries harbour, you will cruise through famous Marigot Bay, one of the loveliest tropical inlets in the Caribbean, famous setting for the film Doctor Dolittle' and many well-known movies. Just five minutes away you will stop at Caribelle Batik, the home of the silky West Indian Sea Island Cotton, where the fascinating batik process comes alive. It is not only the artistic processes that will fascinate you but also the architecture of the building. This 4-storey Victorian house (haunted according to folklore) stands formidably on the outskirt of Castries and exposes her brow to an inspiring view of the city. The tour continues along the countryside towards the north-eastern section of the island with its lush vegetation to an area called Chassin. Be a part of the St. Lucian traditional practices at one of our Heritage Sites. Upon arrival at the Fond Latisab Creole Park, you will experience Creole traditions and practices that are still enjoyed today. You will be able to see the preparation of farine and cassava bread in the ancient Amerindian manner. You can watch the traditional method of cooking food on macambou leaves. Step aboard your air-conditioned coach for a scenic drive through the rolling hills of the countryside to St. John's Parish Church which is perched on a cliff, 800 feet above sea level, overlooking coastal St. John and the Atlantic Ocean. The church contains an interesting sculpture depicting the Madonna and Child with the infant St. John. The graveyard contains the tomb of Ferdinand Paleologus, a descendent of the Byzantine Imperial family, who died in Barbados in 1678 after being a resident for over 20 years. Continue on to Flower Forest, which sits on 6 acres of land, some 800 feet above sea level in the central parish of St Thomas. A meandering path winds its way between beautiful outcrops of coral, rock gardens, cool shady gullies and ponds. Wonderful photo opportunities abound for the professional and amateur photographer. Your last stop, Sunbury House, dates back to 1650. The house was destroyed by fire in 1995, and was gracefully restored and re-opened in 1996. It possesses one of the country's superior collections of antiques. The cellars, originally used for storing yams and other root vegetables grown on the plantation, now house a unique collection of antique carriages, the largest collection in the Caribbean, as well as many items used in the domestic life of the plantation. Sunbury Plantation House, located in the tranquil St. Philip countryside, is a living monument to plantation life of a bygone era, carefully restored and lovingly cherished by its owners for posterity, for the enjoyment of generations to come.



Neglected and forgotten over the course of the years due to the competition of modern transport, they are currently making their comeback to provide you with the opportunity of savoring the charm of Grenada in the early days! Nothing has changed: bright colors, and deliciously padded wooden benches. So, off we go for a truly local cocktail. Grenada's capital is very British in nature with the Carenage, an adorable little harbor set in the hollow of an ancient volcano. This is our point of departure from where we launch ourselves in the assault of St George's, following a labyrinth of roads reminiscent of San Francisco, Caribbean style! And on board of the Creole buses, the drive takes a turn for the unexpected! It is indeed a bit of a climb to reach the heights of Grenadian history; we are on our way to the sumptuous panoramas that can be admired from the old forts: Fort George and Fort Frederick. Fort George overlooks the small capital. Its ancient stones and rocks tell the tale of the culture shock between England and France in the old days; as for Fort Frederick, it stands dominant above the tropical rainforest and the Caribbean Sea, offering a panoramic view of 360 degree. Leaving Fort Frederick behind you, you head to the south of the island, "surfing" the hill tops, as the bus follows the road along the tropical hills and slides down the rural delight of the Grenadian countryside. It is only on the beach, with your feet in the water, your head below the sea grape trees and a rum punch in your hand that we propose an end to this Creole escapade! Well-protected behind high walls, you will travel about one century back in time: no conveyor belts, no machines; the long processing chain of this precious spice starts off in the hands and nimble fingers of the kind-hearted "mammas". Here you enter in the kingdom of women! Humble and conscientious, their movements are founded day after day in the long tradition of secrets of nutmeg, placing these ageless sites second in the world of exporting nations. On your way back, you make a tiny detour to enjoy a swim in the natural lovely pool at the Concord Falls. There you will discover a very particular type of plantation. Here the nutmeg and cocoa trees grow along the flanks of the hills in the tropical forest that is forever near. Please note: it is not permitted to take photographs inside the Nutmeg factory.

Without a doubt, Grenada is one of the most charming islands in the Caribbean. The unspoiled natural beauty is what makes the island so unique. Our first stop is at Clark's Court, a rum distillery unlike any other and one of the most interesting historical sites. The factory has been in operation since 1937, and is situated in the southern part of the island, in the Parish of St. George's.
